In April, monthly gas sales volume totaled 714 million cubic meters, down by 0.6% from the previous year. The sales profiles in each customer category are as shown below.

[Residential]

The gas sales volume decreased by 0.3% from the same month in the previous year, due to higher temperatures of the air, which caused decrease of heating and hot water demand.

[Non-Residential - Industrial]

The gas sales volume decreased by 1.8% from the same month in the previous year, due to decrease in capacity utilization of our customers' facilities.

[Non-Residential - Commercial]

The gas sales volume increased by 1.5% from the same month in the previous year, due to an acquisition of new customers.

[Non-Residential - Public and Medical]

The gas sales volume decreased by 0.3% from the same month in the previous year, due to higher temperatures of the air, which caused decrease of heating and hot water demand.
