

Osaka Gas Builds Amagasaki-Kumiyama Line (provisional name)

Osaka Gas Co., Ltd. (President: Takehiro Honjo) will build a high-pressure natural gas pipeline, aiming to complete the construction work in September 2028. The pipeline will run from Amagasaki City, Hyogo Prefecture (Amagasaki Governor Station) to Kumiyama-cho, Kuse-gun, Kyoto Prefecture (Kumiyama Valve Station).

In response to the growing needs for natural gas, an earth-friendly clean energy source with low environmental impact, Osaka Gas seeks to further stabilize its supply in the Kansai region through the construction of this pipeline.

Osaka Gas will continue to strive for stable energy supply and energy safety and respond to its customers, shareholders, and local communities.
