

Implementation of the "Heartful Bento Project" **-Supporting Medical Workers Fighting the Novel Coronavirus-**

On July 16 and 17, 2020, Osaka Gas Co., Ltd. (President: Takehiro Honjo, hereinafter "Osaka Gas") and Daigas Energy Co., Ltd. (President: Masayuki Inoue, hereinafter "Daigas Energy"), in collaboration with Sunplaza Co., Ltd. (President: Tuyoshi Yamaguchi, hereinafter "Sunplaza"), Chuo Food Service K. K. (President: Yoshiaki Kanda, hereinafter "Chuo Food Service"), Tsuji Culinary Institute (School Headmaster: Yoshiki Tsuji), Eco Truck Co., Ltd. (President: Masanobu Ikeda, hereinafter "Eco Truck"), Epic Corporation (President: Chiaki Kobana, hereinafter "Epic"), and ERECTA International Corporation (President: Takashi Yanagiya, hereinafter "ERECTA"), will implement the "Heartful Bento Project" (hereinafter "this project") to provide *bento* (lunch boxes) to three hospitals in Osaka Prefecture as support for medical workers fighting the novel coronavirus.

This project was originated by Daigas Energy, which is involved in energy-related service proposals to hospitals, in order to support medical workers, and jointly planned and operated by companies that sympathize with the intent.

In this project, lunch boxes for a total of 200 people will be cooked at Osaka Gas "hu+g MUSEUM" over the two days of July 16 and 17. The lunch boxes will be delivered to three hospitals in Osaka Prefecture by using eco-friendly natural gas vehicles and provided to their staff. Osaka Gas and Daigas Energy will serve as the organizers, Sunplaza will provide ingredients, and Chuo Food Service and Tsuji Culinary Institute will develop the menu and do the cooking. Cooked lunch boxes will be packed in cooler boxes provided by Epic and ERECTA and delivered by Eco Truck.

While an increasing number of customers are affected by the novel coronavirus, the Daigas Group aims to become a corporate group that contributes to the further evolution of customers' lives and businesses by utilizing the experience gained through this project.
