

Osaka Gas Starts COVID-19 Vaccination at Workplaces

Today (on June 21), in response to the announcement of the government's policy on COVID-19 vaccination at workplaces, Osaka Gas Co., Ltd. (President: Masataka Fujiwara) started workplace vaccination of the employees working for the Daigas Group or its partner companies and wanting to get the vaccine.

Osaka Gas plans to give vaccine priority to employees engaged in the tasks of maintaining social functions (e.g., gas production, supply and safety, and power generation) and those with underlying medical conditions and then gradually relax the eligibility criteria.

The Daigas Group will continue to ensure thorough measures against the spread of COVID-19 infection and strive for infection control and stable energy supply.

1. Overview

- Start date: Monday, June 21, 2021
- End date: To be decided depending on the progress of vaccination
- Place: Daigas Group Health Development Center (2-37 Chiyozaki 3-chome-minami, Nishi-ku, Osaka City)
- Vaccine: Moderna vaccine provided by the government

2. Vaccine eligibility

- Eligibility: Employees working for the Daigas Group or its partner companies and wanting to get the vaccine (Vaccine priority will be given to those engaged in the tasks of maintaining social functions and those with underlying medical conditions.)
- Scale of vaccination: About 400 people per day (planned)

3. Vaccination system

- Vaccination will be administered mainly by the industrial doctors and other medical staff working for the Health Development Center.
- As far as Osaka Gas employees are concerned, receiving a vaccination during work hours will be treated as engaging in work.
