

**Osaka Gas Signs an Agreement on the D-Green Series,  
Its New Electricity Rate Plans, with Shimadzu Corporation**

Osaka Gas Co., Ltd. (President: Masataka Fujiwara, “Osaka Gas”) signed an agreement on its new electricity rate plans in the D-Green series with Shimadzu Corporation (President: Teruhisa Ueda, “Shimadzu”) and its group companies. Under this agreement, Osaka Gas will start supplying electricity derived 100% from renewable energy sources (“renewable electricity”) in July 2021.

This will be Osaka Gas’s first time to supply renewable electricity in the D-Green series.

The D-Green series is a group of electricity rate plans that supply renewable electricity to corporate customers involved in the promotion of decarbonization. On April 1, 2021, Daigas Energy Co., Ltd. (President: Masayuki Inoue, “Daigas Energy”), a wholly owned subsidiary of Osaka Gas, started to accept applications for the D-Green series as the agency of Osaka Gas to sell the plans.

Shimadzu, Osaka Gas, and Daigas Energy will promote energy conservation through air conditioning that uses DX and will consider efforts to make toward the achievement of a decarbonized society, including the introduction of carbon neutral city gas.

The signed agreement applies to D-Green Premium and D-Green RE100. Both of these rate plans meet the requirements of RE100, an international initiative by companies that aim to source all the electricity they consume in their business activities from renewable electricity.

The D-Green Premium electricity rate plan offers renewable electricity with non-fossil fuel certificates for newly installed power sources that do not use the feed-in tariff system for renewable energy. Use of this rate plan contributes to promoting the development of new renewable energy sources.

The Daigas Group aims to be a corporate group that powers continuous advancement of customers’ lives and businesses. The Group will continue to develop and offer technologies and services toward achieving carbon neutrality and promote efforts that contribute to the global environment in cooperation with customers.
