

Launch of "Sumai Roof" and "Sumai Roof Plus," Free Solar Power Generation System
Installation Services That Contribute to the Realization of a Low-Carbon/Carbon-Neutral
Society

In order to promote the widespread use of renewable energy and realize a carbon-neutral society, on April 1, 2022, Osaka Gas Co., Ltd. (President: Masataka Fujiwara, hereinafter "Osaka Gas") will launch "Sumai Roof," a service that allows customers living in existing and new detached houses in the service area of Osaka Gas to install a solar power generation system without any initial cost, and "Sumai Roof Plus," which includes the lease of a storage battery system as an optional service.

"Sumai Roof" is a service in which Osaka Gas installs a solar power generation system on the roof of a customer's house free of charge and supplies electricity generated by the system to the customer. Electricity generated by the solar panel during daytime is preferentially supplied to the household, which reduces its electricity purchase from the grid and contributes to the environment by reducing CO₂ emissions, as well as to the improvement of the energy-saving performance of the house. Of electricity generated by the solar power generation system, the portion consumed by the household is billed by Osaka Gas.

"Sumai Roof Plus," a service that combines the lease of a storage battery system with "Sumai Roof," makes it possible to store electricity generated by a solar power generation system in the storage battery system, which allows users to feel secure even if a power outage occurs at night. This service also includes the provision of "Tsunagaru-De Alarm System Sumapiko," a device to provide disaster information, and "Sumikata Plus," a service in which the service staff of Osaka Gas responds to housing troubles for free, which allows users to feel even more secure in their overall lives.

The Daigas Group has been striving to reduce CO₂ emissions through the promotion of the introduction of "double power generation systems," which combine a household cogeneration system and a solar power generation system.

In line with the Daigas Group Carbon Neutral Vision announced in January 2021, the new services will further contribute to the realization of a low-carbon/carbon-neutral society, as well as help reduce customers' anxiety about emergency events in their lives. The Daigas Group will continue to strive to become a corporate group that powers continuous advancement in customers' lives and business.

1. Sumai Roof (overview)

Osaka Gas installs a solar power generation system at the customer's home free of charge. Electricity consumed at home is charged by

Osaka Gas at a fixed rate, and surplus electricity is sold by Osaka Gas to an electric power company and the sales become Osaka Gas's income.

2. Sumai Roof Plus (overview)

This service combines the above "Sumai Roof," in which a solar power generation system is installed free of charge, and "Rakutoku Lease," a paid lease of a storage battery system.

In addition, "Tsunagaru-De Alarm System Sumapiko" and "Sumikata Plus" are available free of charge during the contract period.
