

**OGIS-RI Acquires All Shares of Ammic**  
**--The OGIS-RI Group Aims for Further Growth of Its ERP Business--**

OGIS-RI Co., Ltd. (President: Masakazu Nakazawa, hereinafter “OGIS-RI”), a wholly owned subsidiary of Osaka Gas Co., Ltd. (Representative Director and President: Masataka Fujiwara, hereinafter “Osaka Gas”), has acquired all shares of Ammic Corporation (President: Akira Takita, hereinafter “Ammic”), which is engaged in the development, introduction and operation support of package products of mission-critical operation systems for manufacturers (hereinafter, “ERP packages”), and made it its wholly owned subsidiary on January 31, 2023.

The OGIS-RI Group provides comprehensive service, from the development to the operation of mission-critical systems of the Daigas Group, as well as a wide range of services to customers outside the Daigas Group. As a system for centralizing the management of customers’ corporate activities and contributing to efficient business management, ERP packages are being introduced by a broad range of industries, including manufacturing. Supporting the introduction of the products (hereinafter, the “ERP business”) is one of the core businesses of the OGIS-RI Group.

Aiming to further develop the ERP business, OGIS-RI welcomed Agnie Consulting Corp (hereinafter, “Agnie Consulting”), which is strong in ERP introduction consulting services mainly for manufacturers, to the OGIS-RI Group in October 2017. It has also been expanding its business scale and business areas aggressively through initiatives such as investing in Agnie Consulting India PVT Ltd. (hereinafter, “Agnie India”), which is engaged in business and IT consulting in India, in November 2021 to acquire and train highly skilled global IT human resources.

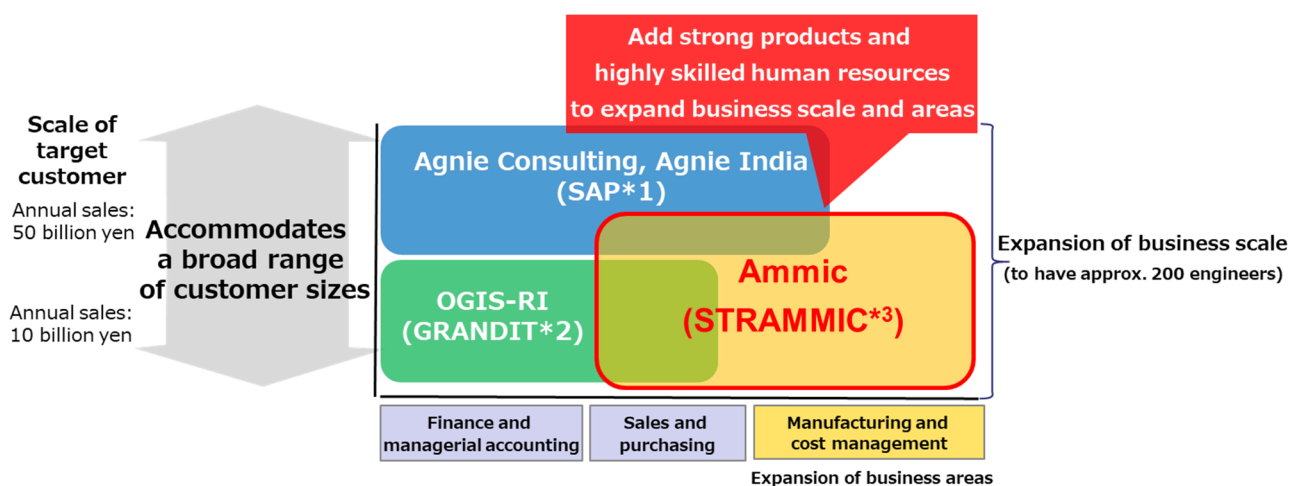
Since its founding, the new Group company Ammic has constantly been engaged in the development, sales, introduction support and subsequent maintenance services of ERP packages for manufacturers. It is especially strong in the construction of systems for manufacturing and cost management. Based on its vision to “support the brilliant field power of Japan’s manufacturing industry over the long term with more flexible package systems,” Ammic trains human resources and develops products to enhance the competitiveness of manufacturing businesses operating worldwide.

As the OGIS-RI Group’s strengths in the areas of accounting, sales and purchasing and Ammic’s strengths in manufacturing and cost management are integrated through this share acquisition, the value chain of the ERP business will expand further, thereby enabling the provision of solutions that can address a wide

variety of needs mainly of manufacturing customers.

The Daigas Group aims to advance its business portfolio management, which consists of the Domestic Energy Business, the International Energy Business and the Life & Business Solutions (LBS) Business. The OGIS-RI Group's Information Business, which is a part of its LBS Business, provides high-added-value business using digital technologies as the group aims to expand its business areas and business scale.

\*3 STRAMMIC: A domestic ERP package independently developed by Ammic, with strengths in manufacturing and cost management, sales distribution management, and procurement management, which are necessary for supply chain management in the manufacturing industry. The system accommodates batch processing customers who mainly handle food, pharmaceuticals and chemicals, as well as discrete customers, such as those engaged in assembly and machining. It has a track record of coordinating with external systems that include not only SAP or GRANDIT but also ERP packages for accounting and sales management provided by other vendors.
