

## Announcement Concerning Commencement of Commercial Operation of the Yokohama Town Wind Farm

We are pleased to announce that the Yokohama Town Wind Farm (hereinafter “the farm”) started commercial operation in April 2023. Osaka Gas Co., Ltd. (President: Masataka Fujiwara; hereinafter “Osaka Gas”) and Tokyu Land Corporation (President: Hiroaki Hoshino; hereinafter “Tokyu Land”), etc. have jointly invested in the farm through GK Yokohama Town Wind Power (hereinafter “Yokohama Town Wind”).

This onshore wind farm with a power generation capacity of 38MW has been under construction in Yokohama Town, Kamikita District, Aomori Prefecture, since April 2021. As all construction works and procedures were completed in March of this year, the farm started commercial operation by utilizing the FIT program.

The Daigas Group is promoting the development of a wide variety of renewable energy sources, such as solar, wind, and biomass, throughout the country. The Group aims to contribute to the spread of renewable energy power sources worth 5,000 MW<sup>\*1\*2</sup> both within Japan and abroad, including in-house development/ownership and procurement from other companies, by FY2030.

Tokyu Land’s “ReENE” brand holds projects involving a renewable energy business, such as solar, wind, and biomass, all over the country, whose scale is one of the largest in Japan<sup>\*3</sup>. Utilizing this power generation capacity, Tokyu Land achieved 100% renewable electricity at its business sites and company-owned facilities (some excluded) by the end of 2022.

Osaka Gas and Tokyu Land will continue to jointly promote and expand renewable energy, including wind power generation, by leveraging their knowledge of the renewable energy business.

\*1: The renewable energy mentioned here includes energy from power sources to which the FIT program applies, such as solar, wind, and biomass power.

\*2: Osaka Gas’s contribution to spreading renewable energy sources, including those developed and owned by the Company and those procured from other companies, is worth about 1,950 MW so far.

\*3: 86 projects all over the country, including those under development, with rated capacity indicating generating capacity equivalent to approximately 676,000 households (1,405 MW, as of the end of February 2023)
