

Implementation of FY2025 Comprehensive Disaster Drill

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Osaka Gas Co., Ltd.

Osaka Gas Co., Ltd. (President: Masataka Fujiwara, hereinafter referred to as "Osaka Gas") today conducted a Daigas Group-wide comprehensive disaster prevention drill assuming a magnitude 6.8 earthquake with an epicenter in the southern part of Kyoto Prefecture. In this drill, the company verified issues regarding business continuity in parallel with disaster response operations in order to strengthen its comprehensive disaster response capabilities.

In this year's drill, based on the assumption that an earthquake with a maximum seismic intensity of 7 had occurred at 22:00 on a weekday, the company set up a countermeasures headquarters with the president as the director and conducted a practical initial response drill with the aim of further improving disaster response capabilities by promoting understanding of how to respond in the event of a disaster at night.

In order to further improve disaster response capabilities, each organization of the company will address the issues found in this drill.

The Daigas Group will continue to enhance its countermeasures against and preparation for earthquakes and other disasters to ensure a safe and stable supply of city gas.
