

Announcement Concerning Decommissioning of Nagoya Power Plant

Nakayama Nagoya Joint Power Generation Co., Ltd. (Representative Director and President: Keiichi Tanaka), a subsidiary^{*1} of Osaka Gas Co., Ltd. (Representative Director and President: Masataka Fujiwara; hereinafter, “Osaka Gas”), has decided to decommission the Nagoya Power Plant (hereinafter, the “Power Plant”), one of its two coal and biomass co-firing power plants, by the end of March 2027.

The Japanese government has set a goal of reducing greenhouse gas emissions by 46% of fiscal 2013 levels by fiscal 2030 in the 7th Strategic Energy Plan released in February 2025 and is promoting the phaseout of power generation coming from coal, which has a relatively large environmental impact among fossil fuels.

Since commercial operations began in April 2000, the Power Plant has contributed to the stable supply of electricity to the region. However, from the perspectives of aging equipment and environmental impact, it will be decommissioned by the end of March 2027.

The Daigas Group would like to express our sincere gratitude to the local community and all other parties concerned for their tremendous support and cooperation in the commercial operation of the Power Plant, and we will continue to strive for the safe and stable operation of the Power Plant until it is decommissioned.

The Daigas Group will continue to strive to reduce the burden on the environment and realize a sustainable society.
